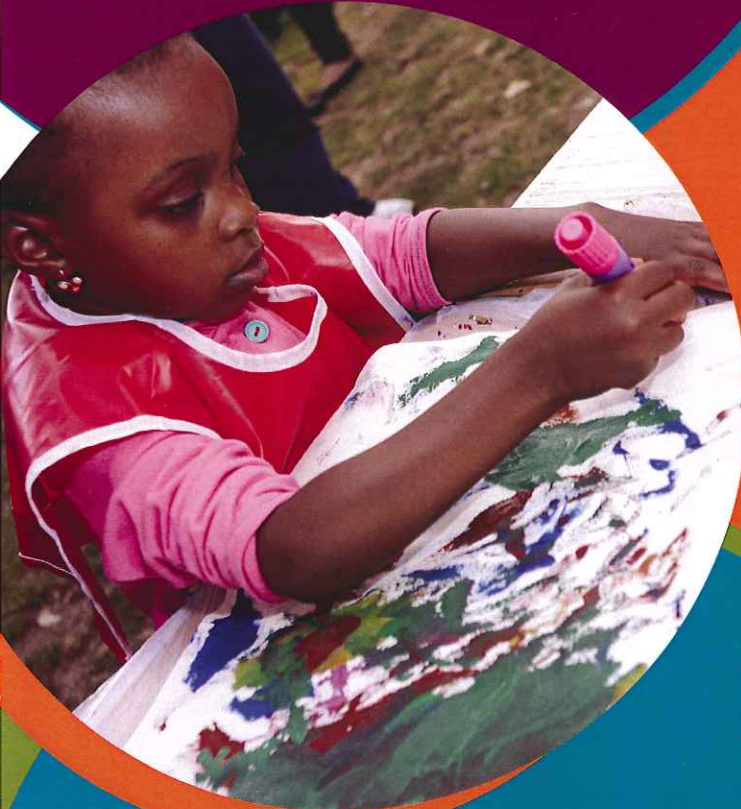


# Attention parents!

More children are eligible for free early years education for two-year-olds



Your child may be entitled to up to 15 hours per week of free early years education, starting the term after their second birthday.

Subject to meeting income criteria.

Can I get a free place for my child?



## Your child will qualify for a free place if you get:

- Income support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance (JSA)
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Support under immigration and asylum law
- The guaranteed part of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit and you have an annual income of £16,190 before tax or less
- Working tax credits and earn no more than £16,190 per year.

## Children qualify in their own right if:

- We look after them
- They have a child protection plan
- They have a disability living allowance
- A current statement of special educational needs (SEN)
- An education, health and care plan
- Left care through special guardianship or an adoption or residence order.

When is my child entitled to a free place?

If your child's second birthday is between:	He/she will become entitled to a free place from:
1 January – 31 March	the start of the summer term (after Easter)
1 April – 31 August	the start of the autumn term (early September)
1 September – 31 December	the start of the spring term (early January)
